

YOU TOLD US, WE LISTENED: SHARING EVALUATION FINDINGS



This evaluation tool can be used to support the learning-focused function of evaluation. Documenting what “you told us” and how “we listened” supports sport organizations to maintain accountability to their stakeholders, including athletes, coaches, administrators, sponsors/funders, spectators, media, and others. The tool can be used to reflect on evaluation findings and/or the evaluation process itself.
