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To promote innovative and collaborative research to improve the prevention, diagnosis, prediction of recovery, and treatment of concussion

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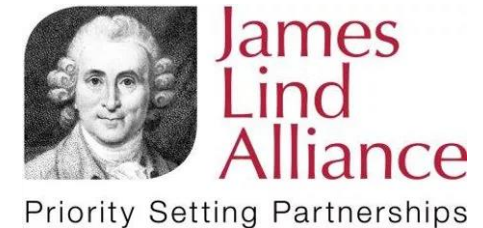
To inform best practice and policy in concussion prevention, management, and treatment through continuous engagement with patients, the public, and other stakeholders

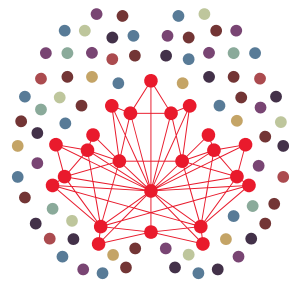
