

### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS – POSTING A CAREER AND/OR OPPORTUNITY**

#### 1. Purpose

a. These Terms and Conditions describe how a not-for-profit organizations involved in the development of sport in Canada can post a career or opportunity to the SIRC website and which will also be distributed via the SIRC daily news service.

## 2. Posting a Career or Opportunity

- a. Jobs posted on the SIRC Career page are intended to be sport and physical activity related.
- b. SIRC distributes the job announcements, however is not responsible for the content, accuracy or quality of each posting or posting organization.
- c. The content is the responsibility of the employer or posting organization.
- d. Posting organizations agree to post only positions that meet the employment standards, rules and regulations as governed by their province/jurisdiction and/or the Government of Canada (including but not limited to internships, volunteers, Board members, full-time and part-time employees, contractors, accessibility standards, human rights, etc.).
- e. Effective May 1, 2024, our annual subscription includes 10 job postings per year, each with a 60-day cap. Volunteer and board member positions may be considered beyond the 10-post limit on a case-by-case basis for added flexibility.
- f. Each job posting must be for one (1) job opportunity; it is not permitted for a Posting to solicit applications for more than one position.
- g. Sport job postings are to be for the organization holding the SIRC Premier Subscription and do not include postings for or on behalf of their members or member organizations.

### 3. Removal and Modification

- a. SIRC reserves the right to accept, refuse or remove the career or opportunity listing.
- b. SIRC reserves the right to update, modify and/or change available resources at its discretion.

a. SIRC distributes the job announcements however is not responsible for the content, accuracy or quality of each posting or posting organization. The content is the responsibility of the employer or posting organization.
