This position focuses on designing scalable IT models, aligning technology solutions with organizational priorities, and collaborating with senior leadership to implement cost-effective, future-ready systems. A strategic visionary, the role encompasses oversight of business applications, information management, IT infrastructure, and cybersecurity, ensuring they support both current needs and long-term goals.

- Oversee the integration of digital systems, including LMS, registration platforms, event management tools, and internal communication systems.
- Lead cross-departmental technology initiatives and ensure alignment with user needs and organizational workflows.



• Manage all IT service providers and contractors to ensure delivery on time, budget, and quality standards.
